











Maryland Legislative Fellowship Program



The Legislative Fellows Program offers top students in Maryland graduate programs an immersive experience in the legislative process working alongside nonpartisan professional staff within the Department of Legislative Services (DLS), the staff agency for the Maryland General Assembly (MGA). Fellows begin the

program in mid-October and work through the General Assembly's annual 90-day legislative session (Jan – April). A \$7,500 stipend is included.

The Program is specifically designed for graduate students (in all majors) at Maryland institutions offering master's degrees in public policy.

Who Should Apply

Graduate students with a demonstrated interest in pursuing a career in legislative / public policy work should consider the legislative fellowship.
